A total of \$1,000 will be awarded in the following categories: Oil/Acrylic, Watercolor/Water Media, Mixed Media (Pastel, Drawing & Enhanced photos), Sculpture, and Photography. Enter any subject matter and category placement will be determined by the show committee with final approval by the judges. A critique and reception for artists and their families, and members of the Salmon River Art Guild will begin at 7:00pm, announcement of winners at 7:30pm, with doors opening and critiques to begin immediately following at the Best Western Salmon Rapids Lodge.

The Art Guild will also be featuring a silent auction during the show. If you have art that you would like to donate 100% or a lesser percentage of the proceeds for the auction contact us at the numbers below. Please put a dollar amount as the first bid if you wish an unsold donation to be returned to you.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. Open to all artists 18 and over in any fine media.
2. Any entry the show committee decides is a craft rather than fine art will not be accepted. All work must be original, and has not previously been entered in the Salmon River Art Guild Fall Show and not done under a teacher's supervision. Compositions taken from a published source are not eligible. **Work must have been completed in the last two years.**
3. Each entry must be ready for display: properly framed to hang. **Please use wire for hanging. Saw tooth hangers or Velcro will not be accepted. Artwork size must not exceed 110" in circumference total including the frame. Due to space limitations, we cannot make exceptions.**
4. A non-refundable entry fee of \$10.00 per entry is required upon submission of work. Limit of five (5) entries per artist. Entry forms are attached for your use, and we would appreciate you having them filled out when you enter your work. Work may or may not be for sale. There is a 30% commission on sales.
5. Entries must be brought to Best Western Salmon Rapids Lodge on Friday, October 7th from 10:00 am – 5 pm (MDT). No work will be accepted after 5 pm (MDT).
6. Final approval of artwork accepted will rest with the show committee and must be suitable for family viewing. Placement of art in the show will rest with the show committee.
7. All entries to remain on exhibit until the closing of the show on Sunday, October 9th, at 3pm (MDT). No exceptions. Arrangements to pick up entries after the show's closing should be made.
8. Every precaution will be taken to protect all entries. However, the Salmon River Art Guild, the Best Western Salmon Rapids Lodge or their representatives will assume no liability to loss, theft, or damage.

Mary Bakker began art work in the third grade and has continued her passion to this day. Mary is an award winning artist who paints mostly in oils but also enjoys pastels and watercolor. As an active member of the Salmon River Art Guild she has given numerous workshops to the members. Many of Mary's pieces have won "Best of Show" and ribbons in the past 20 years. She has been accepted into the Idaho Paints Idaho Show and in 2006 was in the traveling show. Mary is a member of SRAG, and the Central Idaho Art Association.

Larry Ferguson is a native of the Norwest and grew up in Lewiston, ID. He graduated from LHS, and earned his B.A. degree in Fine Arts for the University of Idaho, Moscow. Then he moved to Iowa City, IA where he earned a M.A and M.F.A in Studio art. Larry taught art at Dakota State College in Madison, SD for six years then moved back to Iowa where he taught at Iowa State University in Ames for four years before moving back to Clarkston in 1978. Larry continues to teach art workshops through the Valley Art Center. Although he painted in oil for several years, before developing an allergy to the solvent, his first love has always been watercolor. His work is exhibited widely in both one-man and competitive competitions, and he has work in private collection in twenty states and in Europe.
